**Blue Star Mothers Welcome Opportunity to meet in Historic Veterans Hall**

Buckeye Military Moms Chapter 9 of the Blue Star Mothers of America, Inc., are relocating their meetings to the historic Sharon Memorial Hall in Worthington. The first meeting at this new location will be held at 7 pm on February 19, 2009. The Chapter will meet monthly on the third Thursday.

Trina Dunlap, the 2009 new President of the Chapter, said, "We invite any eligible parents from central Ohio to attend and to help us fortify our activities in support of our young men and women who serve our country." The Blue Star Mothers are mothers who now have or have had children honorably serving in the military. They are a non-profit, non-political service organization supporting each other and their children while promoting patriotism, and assisting veterans.
